Arrow Minerals Limited (**Arrow Minerals** or the **Company**) is pleased to advise it has completed Tranche 1 of the capital raising advised on 26 June 2019 to raise \$570,000 through the placement of 57,000,000 shares at an issue price of 1¢ per share (**Placement**).
