PERFORMANCE RIGHTS & SHARE ISSUE

Pursuant to the Pioneer Resources Limited (the **Company** or **Pioneer**) Incentive Performance Rights Plan (**IPR Plan**), a total of 4,000,000 Performance Rights with vesting conditions in the form of performance hurdles were issued to Managing Director, David Crook, following approval by shareholders at the Annual General Meeting held on 20 November 2018. Details of the Performance Rights were contained in the Explanatory Notes section of the Notice of Meeting (refer ASX announcement of 16 October 2018).

In accordance with the IPR Plan and Resolution 11 in the Notice of Meeting, the Board of Directors (excluding David Crook, the Managing Director) has determined that 1,333,600 Performance Rights have vested due to the respective performance hurdle being achieved and the remainder of the Performance Rights totalling 2,666,400 have lapsed due to the respective performance hurdles not being achieved. David Crook has elected to convert the vested performance rights into fully paid ordinary shares.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 708A(5)(e) OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT 2001 (Cth)

This cleansing notice (Cleansing Notice) is given by Pioneer Resources Limited (ASX:PIO) (ACN 103 423 981) (Company) under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act).


