The loan is payable on the third anniversary of each advance plus a real after tax rate of return of 16% on the advanced amount.

The \$1.4 million facility was secured, during the second quarter, with ABSA Bank. The facility is for short term working capital requirements and potential expansion opportunities. The Facility has a floating coupon at the South African Prime rate (currently 10.0% per annum) plus 1.0%, with the operating mine Uitkomst Colliery debtors ceded as security and is subject to annual review.
