## CARBINE RESOURCES LIMITED (ASX: CRB) - REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

We refer to the voluntary suspension granted to Carbine Resources Limited (ASX: CRB) (the "Company") on Wednesday 29 May 2019 and subsequently extended on 5 June, 16 June, 3 July, 17 July and 31 July 2019.

The Company requests an extension to the voluntary suspension of its securities to Wednesday 25 September 2019.

The Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. The reason for the voluntary suspension is for the Company to finalise negotiations with respect to a potential acquisition and to respond to an ASX Price Query. The Company notes that it has lodged a submission with ASX with respect to the potential acquisition.
- 2. The Company requests that the suspension remain in place until the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Wednesday 25 September 2019, or until the release of an ASX announcement regarding the potential acquisition and the ASX Price Query.
- 3. The event that will end the voluntary suspension is the announcement referred to in paragraph 2.

The Company is not aware of any reason why this voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
