

Saints and Leinster Nickel Acquisitions Completed

Auroch Minerals Limited (ASX:AOU) (**Auroch** or **Company**) is pleased to announce it has successfully completed its acquisition of 100% of the tenements known as the Saints Nickel Project (**Saints**) and the Leinster Nickel Project (**Leinster**) from Minotaur Exploration Limited (**ASX:MEP**, **Minotaur**) on the terms as set out in the ASX announcement dated 11 July 2019.

A total of 18,333,333 shares were issued to the vendors as consideration for the acquisition which are subject to a voluntary escrow period of 12 months. A further 1,833,333 shares were issued to the party that introduced, negotiated and more broadly supported the transaction over the preceding six months, the party has agreed to an escrow period of 6 months for half of these shares and 12 months for the remaining half.

"The formal completion of the Acquisition of Saints and Leinster marks the commencement of the next stage for Auroch to commence exploration of its nickel projects. With the maiden drill programme to commence in September at Saints and the LME nickel price around US\$16,000/t, it is an exciting time for the Company and its shareholders as it continues its strategy of aggressively exploring for base-metals in Australia". - said Aidan Platel, Auroch CEO





Figure 1 – Location of the Leinster and the Saints Nickel Projects
