





### **Identified Prospects**

- Access to historical database (worth \$millions), including drill core
- Data acquisition and compilation of 79 historical holes ongoing.
- Reprocessed airborne geophysical data confirmed presence of four Cupric Canyon style domes and four potential subsurface "intact" domal structures similar to MOD Resources T3 deposit
- Multiple historic copper intersections require follow up
- New licence (PL7264) awarded May 2019


### **Exploration Underway**


#### **PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS**

- NSAMT ground geophysical survey has delineated an interpreted D'Kar/Ngwako Pan Formation contact position within 200 m below surface
- Interpreted conductors analogous to potential black shales have been identified, as observed with the MOD Resources T3 project.
- Extensive calcrete noted in the area and within the only historical drillhole close to the recent NSAMT survey line.
- Otjari Domal Prospect interpreted as 25km in strike length.

#### PLANNED ACTIVITIES

- Diamond drilling program commenced mid Sept 19
- Additional NSAMT lines across the interpreted domal strike length
- Airborne EM Survey


### **Exploration ongoing**

#### **PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS**

- NSAMT ground geophysical survey has delineated an interpreted D'Kar/Ngwako Pan Formation contact position.
- Initial copper (chalcopyrite and bornite) intersections in first diamond drillhole at the Ongava project.
- Interpretation indicates Ongava dome becomes shallower to the East.
- Ongava Domal Prospect interpreted approximately 34km in strike length.

#### **PLANNED ACTIVITIES**

- Further drilling
- Further NSAMT lines to the east, as the dome is interpreted to shallow
- Airborne EM Survey






### **BOTSWANA – KORONG DOME AND KARA DOME**

#### **KORONG PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS**

- Regional scale 1,091km<sup>2</sup> airborne electromagnetic (EM) survey completed
- 3,698m drill program completed late 2018
- Initial geological interpretation has confirmed D'Kar Formation from as shallow as 5m from surface
- Reconnaissance drilling confirms the presence of associated "pathfinder sulphides"
- Korong prospectivity continues to improve

#### KARA PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Kara Dome is located within the central structural corridor, known to host the majority of recent copper-silver discoveries
- Pathfinder alteration and sulphide minerals observed in previous initial reconnaissance drilling program
