Attack close to Boungou Mine Site in Burkina Faso

Perenti advises that yesterday there was a security incident approximately 40kms from Semafo's Bongou mine site in Burkina Faso involving members of our workforce from African Mining Services (AMS).

A convoy of five buses, escorted by military police, came under attack. The convoy included local AMS employees, Semafo employees and other suppliers of Semafo.

It is with deep sadness that Perenti advises that the information we have to date is that there have been a number of fatalities and injuries, however, we are still working to confirm details with local authorities.

Emergency response procedures were activated and the immediate location around the incident has been secured.

We are currently working with local authorities to ensure the safety and well-being of our workforce. This is our highest priority.

Our thoughts and prayers are with those affected by this attack and with their families.

We are considering the implications of the incident and of the security situation in Burkina Faso more generally and will be engaging with Semafo through this process.
