CARBINE RESOURCES LIMITED (ASX: CRB) - REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

We refer to the voluntary suspension initially granted to Carbine Resources Limited (ASX: CRB) (the "Company") on Wednesday 29 May 2019 and subsequently extended.

The Company requests an extension to the voluntary suspension of its securities to Monday 10 February 2020.

The Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. The reason for the voluntary suspension is for the Company to finalise an announcement with respect to a potential acquisition and to respond to an ASX Price Query.
- 2. The Company requests that the suspension remain in place until the commencement of normal trading on Monday 10 February 2020.
