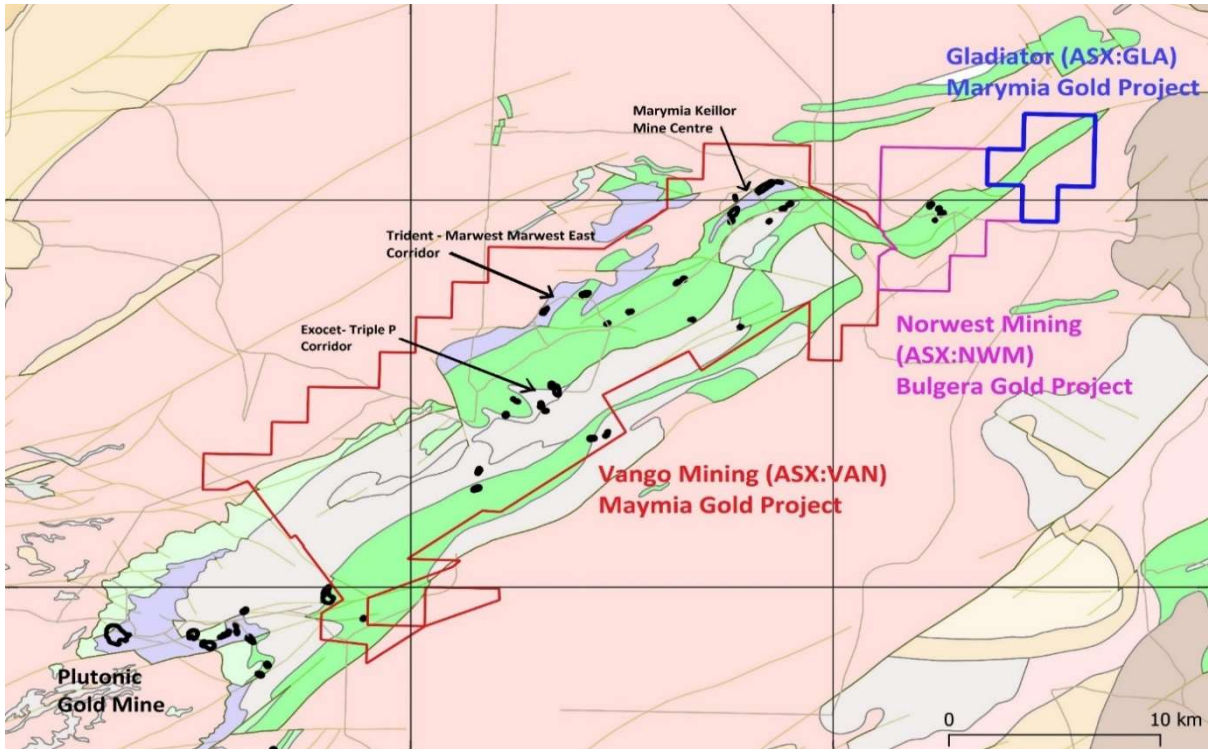
Gladiator Resources Limited (ASX: GLA) is pleased to announce it has received approval for Aircore (AC) drilling to be completed at its Marymia Gold Project along strike of untested anomalous RAB intersections. AC drilling will also be extended to test untested greenstone to the NE corner of the tenement and south of anomalous MHRB008 to test the southern margin of the greenstone belt. Successful AC drilling will result in future RC drilling.

The company proposes to complete reconnaissance field work ahead of the commencement of the proposed drilling campaign and is currently finalising relevant clearances.

The Marymia Gold Project comprises granted exploration license E52/3104 and is located at the north east end of the ~50km long Plutonic Greenstone Belt. The Plutonic Belt hosts the world class Plutonic and Marymia gold mine centres some ~45km and ~10km respectively to the south west, see figure 1.

Vango Mining Ltd (ASX: VAN) is actively exploring and developing gold resources in a large tenement holding in the area and has recently reported exceptionally high-grade results at its Albatross – Flamingo target.

As previously announced GLA is continuing to work through available data to highlight further areas of interest and develop additional work programmes.
