#### **Item 3 - Terms of Performance Rights**

#### **Vesting Condition of the Performance Rights**

The Company as agreed to grant Performance Rights to the Managing Director (or his nominee). The conditions that must be met in order for the Performance Rights to vest are as follows:

- (a) Class A2 Performance Rights require that the Company must have a 30 day VWAP of NTM shares on ASX of not less than 7.5 cents per share for any period prior to 31 November 2021.
- (b) Class B2 Performance Rights require that the Company must have a 30 day VWAP of NTM shares on ASX of not less than 10.0 cents per share for any period prior to 31 November 2021.
