

## **APPENDIX 4C FOR QUARTER ENDED 31<sup>st</sup> DECEMBER 2019**

**Friday 31 January 2020:** Property Connect Holdings Limited (ASX: PCH) ('Property Connect' or 'the Company') today lodged its Appendix 4C quarterly report of cash flows for the quarter ended 31 December 2019 with the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX).

### **Financial and Strategic Update**

Property Connect reported a cash balance of \$218,000 at 31 December 2019.

Net operating cash flow for the quarter was (\$179,000), representing the Company's ongoing operational activities. Operational costs continued to be kept to a minimum during the period while the Company maintained the LiveOffer platforms and sought to identify synergistic opportunities for commercialisation of the LiveOffer platforms along with alternative transactions which will add shareholder value. Estimated cash outflows for next quarter include costs incurred for the month of December 2019 which were paid in January 2020.

As set out in the Appendix 4C released to ASX on 31 October 2019, ASX has notified the Company that if it does not demonstrate compliance with Listing Rule 12.1 to the ASX's satisfaction by 24 April 2020, ASX may suspend the Company's securities from official quotation.

The Company continues to seek transactions which will add shareholder value and will keep the market updated on the progress of its discussions in relation to any potential transactions.
