FOD receives first order for \$2 million of hand sanitiser

Highlights

- Coronavirus outbreak has created a shortage of hand sanitiser in the Asia-Pacific region with numerous pharmacies and distribution channels running out of the product
- FOD's newly installed bottling line in Melbourne has capacity to produce hand sanitiser under the Sanicare brand
- FOD has received an order for more than \$2 million of hand sanitiser products which will be sold through distribution partner Careline Australia Pty Ltd
- First order expected to be filled and cash received within four weeks
- FOD's expects further orders to materialise

The Food Revolution Group Limited (ASX: FOD) is pleased to announce it has received a \$2 million first order for hand sanitiser from its distribution partner Careline Australia Pty Ltd, following its announcement earlier this week (18 February 2020) that it would commence hand sanitiser production from its upgraded plant in Melbourne.





Newly installed bottling line at Mill Park

Hand sanitiser is in high demand due to the global Coronavirus outbreak, which prompted FOD to investigate its capacity to produce the hygiene product from its newly installed bottling line at its Mill Park processing facility. It has sourced the ingredients for an alcohol-based hand sanitiser and expects to commence production before the end of February 2020.

FOD's first hand sanitiser order is for \$2,016,000. The order will be filled by FOD as well as contracted manufacturers, including Careline's manufacturing plant in Sydney, to ensure the order is

filled and delivered in the shortest timeframe. All sales of the product will be sold through FOD by agreement between FOD and Careline.

FOD has ordered the bottles required and it is anticipated that this order can be filled in the next four weeks.

Careline Australia Pty Ltd, FOD's distribution partner controlled by Chairman Norman Li, has received unprecedented demand for hand sanitiser locally and from China, which is in short supply due to the Coronavirus. Careline will distribute the FOD products through both its Daigou network and to fill orders it has directly from supermarkets and distribution customers.

Dr Li commented: "We believe this is the first of many orders for our hand sanitiser product. Careline has demand for this product from both Australian supermarkets and pharmacy chains as well as direct demand from China. FOD's aim is to build these distribution channels so that FOD can continue to supply them beyond the current Corinavirus outbreak."
