## Completion of \$3.5m Placement – Appendix 2A

**MGC Pharmaceuticals Ltd (ASX: MXC, 'MGC Pharma'** or **'the Company')**, a European based 'Seed to Medicine' bio-pharma company specialising in the development and production of phytocannabinoidderived medicines, is pleased to announce that the placement to raise A\$3.5 million ('**Placement**') at A\$0.027 per share, has been completed today following the issue of 129.63m fully paid ordinary shares ('New Shares') to Placement participants.

As announced 28 April 2020, MGC Pharma secured firm commitments from new and existing institutional and sophisticated investors to raise A\$3.5 million through the issue of 129.63m New Shares at an issue price of A\$0.027 per New Share. New Shares issued under the Placement include one free attaching listed option ('**Option**') for every two New Shares issued, exercisable at A\$0.045 on or before 31 August 2021. The Options are being issued under the Company's prospectus dated 4 May 2020 (**Prospectus**). The issue and quotation of the Options is expected to occur on or around 11 May 2020, in conjunction with the free-attaching options being issued to participants in the Company's Share Purchase Plan.

An Appendix 2A is attached for the quotation of the New Shares and the 1,296,296 fully paid ordinary shares issued as part payment to Canaccord Genuity (Australia) Limited as Lead Manager of the Placement. Following the completion of these share issues today, the Cleansing Offer under the Prospectus has now been closed. The offers for the SPP Options and the Placement Options will remain open, in accordance with the timetable set out in the Prospectus.
