### Keytone Dairy Corporation Limited (ASX:KTD) - Request for trading halt

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Keytone Dairy Corporation Limited (ASX:KTD) (Keytone) requests a trading halt in respect of its ordinary shares (Shares) from commencement of trading today, Wednesday, 6 May 2020.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Keytone provides the following information:
