## **About Artemis Resources Limited**

Artemis Resources (ASX: ARV) is an ASX-listed explorer and developer. In brief, ARV's two main West Australian assets are 100% owned and detailed briefly as follows:

### **WA East Pilbara:**

ARV's 100%-owned Paterson Central Project, in Western Australia's East Pilbara, is an exciting opportunity to explore virgin ground surrounding and proximal to Greatland Gold plc's (LON:GGP) Havieron discovery, which is being developed alongside their farm in partner Newcrest Mining Limited (ASX:NCM).

### **West Pilbara Assets:**

The Greater Carlow project begins just 30km South of Karratha and comprises a Gold, Copper and Cobalt inferred resource<sup>1</sup> which is open in multiple directions at Carlow Castle. The 100% owned Radio Hill Processing Plant and permitted ancillary facilities and ~25km of "regional thrust" geology that the Company intends to methodically explore. ARV see the Greater Carlow Project as an outstanding greenfield and brownfield opportunity with potential to build a multi-million ounce resource base to be served by the regionally strategic Radio Hill Plant once optimised and complete.
