The Directors of Talon Petroleum Ltd (the "Company") request that the Company's securities be placed in a voluntary trading halt immediately in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, pending the release of an announcement by the Company in relation to a capital raising.

The Company requests that the trading halt end Friday 24 July 2020, or when the announcement referred to above is released to the market. In relation to recent ASX guidance on permitted back-to-back trading halts, the Company requests the trading halt is permitted for four (4) trading days and notes the consecutive trading halts are for the purpose of considering, planning and executing a capital raising.
