# Acacia Coal Limited (ASX: AJC) – Suspension from Official Quotation

### **Description**

The securities of Acacia Coal Limited ('AJC') will be suspended from quotation immediately, at the request of AJC regarding the acquisition of Graphene Technology Solutions Limited ('Proposed Acquisition').

ASX has exercised its discretions under Listing Rule 11.1.2 to require the Proposed Acquisition to be conditional on approval by AJC's ordinary security holders and under Listing Rule 11.1.3 to require AJC to recomply with Chapters 1 and 2 of the Listing Rules.

It is expected that AJC's securities will remain suspended until AJC has recomplied with Chapters 1 and 2 of the Listing Rules.
