Cycliq appoints new chairman and non-executive director

Craig Smith-Gander appointed to non-executive Chairman

Xavier Kris appointed to non-executive Director

Having successfully led technology businesses in the USA, Europe, South East Asia and Australia as an operational CEO in high growth environments, Mr Kris is a specialist in transforming single vertical, product-based businesses into international, recurring revenue, high gross margin, platform-based enterprises.

As a director, advisor and executive in public and private companies, he has completed over 15 accretive acquisitions internationally and helped scale organisations organically through strategic partnerships and enterprise sales deals with global marquee clients.

Resignation of incumbent Directors

Incumbent directors, non-executive Chairman Mr Piers Lewis and non-executive Director Ben Rattigan intend to resign from their positions effective 31 August 2020.



Executive Share Option Plan

Subject to shareholder approval, the Company intends to adopt an ESOP to attract, retain and incentivise directors and key executive positions.

Following the above board changes becoming effective, the new Board intends to issue directors and key executives options under the ESOP at a strike price of 0.4cps and an expiry date of up to 2 years from the date of issue. Any issue of options under the ESOP to related parties will be subject to shareholder approval and the number of options to be issued under the ESOP will not exceed 10% of the Company's issued capital.

The Company will keep shareholders informed of future board decisions surrounding the issues of options and the ESOP and will prepare a notice of meeting for the relevant shareholder approvals at the appropriate time.
