Completion of Share Purchase Plan

Sydney, Australia, 24 September 2020 – Splitit Payments Limited ("**Splitit**" or the "**Company**") (ASX:SPT), a global payment solutions provider, confirms the completion of the issue and allotment of the new fully paid ordinary shares ("**SPP Shares**") under the share purchase plan ("**SPP**").

Splitt has today issued to SPP participants approximately 7.75 million SPP Shares at \$1.30 per SPP Shares (being the same issue price as the institutional placement announced to ASX on 5 August 2020 ("**Placement**")) to raise approximately A\$10 million bringing the total gross proceeds raised pursuant to the Placement and the SPP to A\$100 million (before costs).

In accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the SPP Offer Booklet and as previously announced on 18 September 2020, the Company scaled back valid applications received whereby any shareholder who held 501 or more Shares at the Record Date was allocated SPP Shares equal to 11.9% of their valid application and any shareholders who held 500 or less Shares at the Record Date was allocated 100 Shares.

An Appendix 2A in respect of the SPP Shares is enclosed.

Unless otherwise defined, capitalised words in this announcement have the same meaning given to them in the SPP Offer Booklet.
