Predictive Discovery Limited (ASX: PDI) is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr Phillip Jackson to the Company's Board of directors as Non-Executive Chairman. He replaces Mr Phillip Harman who retired from the Board prior to PDI's AGM on 25th November 2014.

PDI also has interests in a strategic portfolio of tenements in Côte D'Ivoire covering a total area of 1,534 km².
