MINISTER SIGNS LICENCE AGREEMENTS FOR CABINDA PROJECT

Highlights:

- Agreements signed with Angolan Ministry of Geology and Mines for new licences on the Cabinda project; and
- New licences will be issued for five years following publication of the signed agreements in the official Angolan public journal.

Minbos Resources Ltd (**Minbos or the Company**) is pleased to advise that the Company and its 50% Joint Venture Partner Petril Projects (**Petri**l) have executed agreements with the Angolan Ministry of Geology and Mines (**MGM**) for new licences on the Cabinda phosphate project (**Cabinda project**) in Angola.

Two new licences will be issued for five years (renewable for a further two years) following publication of the signed agreements with MGM in the official Angolan public journal. The first licence is for the Cacata deposit and the second licence the remainder of the Cabinda project deposits. The new licences replace the old exploration permit (006/06/01/L.P./GOV.ANG.MGM.2010).

The signed contracts with MGM covers not only prospecting rights but also the mining phase of the Cabinda project. On completion of the Environmental Impact and Economic Viability Study the issue of a mining licence can be requested. The mining licence will be valid for thirty five years, renewable for successive periods of ten years.

Minbos Chief Executive Officer Lindsay Reed said: "We are extremely pleased that the agreements leading to new licences on the Cabinda project have been executed. The Cabinda project is without peer in the Atlantic Basin and following the issue of the new licences, Minbos and its joint venture partner Petril will proceed with the bankable feasibility study. In addition there will be continued focus on pursuing capital and operating cost reductions and to extend the high grade component of the resource base."

ABOUT THE CABINDA PROJECT

The Cabinda project covers an area of about 200,000 ha in Angola, of highly prospective ground hosting phosphate ore, consisting of six exploration projects and is a 50/50 joint venture between Minbos and Petril (**JV Partners**).

The JV partners have delineated a substantial resource of 391.3 million tonnes with 2 high grade projects that have been identified at the Cacata and Chivovo Deposits. Some of the studies that have been completed on the Cacata project include Geology, Mining, Test work, Processing, Transport and Shipping. A summary of the JORC resource is shown in Table 1 below:




Figure 1: Map of the Cabinda project exploration area
