Key New Features Added in the Covata 2.15 Release as the Company is Accepted into the Global AllSeen Alliance

SYDNEY – 17 March, 2015 – In the wake of its acceptance into the AllSeen Alliance, Covata Limited (ASX:CVT) (“Covata” or the “Company”), has released the latest version of its software with a number of key updates and features enabling current and future clients to further enhance and secure their collaboration in the cloud.

Covata Safe Share 2.15 Release

- The Covata Safe Share web application, including the Administration, email notifications and Sign-in page now completely support internationalization. Whether users are in Europe, the USA or Asia, Safe Share will secure their data and provide an application interface in a language they are familiar with.
- In addition to OAuth authentication Covata Safe Share now supports integration with SAML authentication. For identity providers or applications that require SAML tokens, the integration is seamless. Covata ensures that administrators are able to use the level of authentication they deem necessary as a business. Most large corporates have existing strong authentication for employees by way of tokens or biometrics; the new SAML support extends these credentials to Safe Share.
- Covata Safe Share continues to expand its foundation in persistent fine-grained data control with Access Control enhancements in the areas of Groups and Labels. This level of data sharing access control gives organizations the granularity needed in todays challenging security environments. For example Labelling ties the classification of a document to the policy associated within the User and/or Group; ‘Restricted Classification’ Label means only restricted/cleared personnel can access the document – regardless of the ‘group’ they may belong to. The credential could be a Government issued token (through SAML integration) to establish the User Identity and Clearance.
- Covata Safe Share has also developed “Transfer of Ownership” technology, providing companies the capability to move secure data from users or sub-groups that have had their access removed from the service – whilst preserving the overarching Group or Policy attributes.
- A further enhancement is “Shared Content,” which allows the owner of a folder to grant access permission to collaborators. Collaborators now have the capability to upload and manage the content within the shared folder.
