Completion of Placement

Latin Resources Limited ('Latin' or 'the Company') is pleased to announce that it has completed the Placement announced to the market on 10 March 2015.

The Company received applications from sophisticated and professional investors for a total of 28,500,000 shares at an average price of \$0.01 per share raising \$285,000 (before costs).

As indicated in the announcement on 10 March 2015, the Placement also involves the issue of one Option for every 2 shares issued, subject to shareholder approval at a general meeting in April or early May 2015.

Each Option will be listed, and allow the holder to acquire an ordinary share in the Company at an exercise price of \$0.02 per share on or before 9 March 2017.

The funds raised from the Placement will be used to progress the Company's projects in South America and for working capital purposes.

Please find attached an Appendix 3B in relation to the final issue of shares from the Placement which are issued in accordance Listing Rule 7.1A.

The Company issued the shares as a Placement to sophisticated and professional investors under LR 7.1A as this was considered to be a more efficient mechanism than an entitlements issue.
