Sprintex Limited (ASX Code: SIX) (**Company**) advises that the issue of shares under its non-renounceable pro rata offer to Eligible Shareholders announced on 24 February 2015 (**Rights Issue**), which closed on 9 April 2015 has been completed.

The share registry has issued 783,463,340 shares to applicants under the Rights Issue (inclusive of shortfall placements placed to date), which raised a total of approximately \$1,566,927 before costs.

The remaining shortfall of 602,017,933 Shortfall Shares can be placed within three months from the 9 April 2015 closing date, i.e. by 9 July 2015, as set out in the Prospectus for the Rights Issue.
