## **Results of General Meeting**

In accordance with Listing Rule 3.13.2 and Section 251AA of the *Corporations Act*, we advise that a General Meeting of the Company was held at Doltone House, Jones Bay Wharf, Piers 19 – 21, Upper Deck, 26 – 32 Pirrama Road, Pyrmont NSW 2009 and each of the following resolutions were approved:

Item 1 – That, for the purposes of section 611, item 7, of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and for all other purposes, approval is given to the Company for the acquisition by Seven Group Holdings Limited (SGH) of a Relevant Interest in the ordinary shares of the Company to be issued to SGH upon conversion of the CPS.

Item 2 – That, for the purposes of section 208 of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and all other purposes, approval is given to the Company for the conversion of the CPS on the terms of the Conversion Agreement as outlined in the Explanatory Memorandum accompanying the Notice of Meeting.
