



BLM denies Federal Permit Extension

Potash Minerals Ltd. (ASX: POK) ("Potash Minerals" or the "Company") advises that the 22 Federal Prospecting Permits held by the Company have reached their two year expiration date on 1 June 2015. The expiry of these permits could restrict K2O Utah's (Potash Minerals' 90% owned Joint Venture vehicle) access to the federal blocks of its Hatch Point Potash Project.

The Company submitted an application for a two year extension with the US Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and on May 28, 2015. Potash Minerals has received a formal determination denying the extension. The Company has reserved it rights to appeal the BLM's decision.

The Company continues to hold the Utah State Leases awarded to the Company on which K2O Utah completed a drilling program in 2012-2013.
