Atlantic Ltd (**Atlantic**) has entered into a forbearance agreement with its largest shareholder and major creditor Droxford International Limited (**Droxford**). Droxford agreed that it will forbear and not take any action, until 6 October 2015, to accelerate any of its convertible bond or promissory note debts that matured in March 2015. Atlantic is now in discussion with Droxford regarding a solvent restructuring of Atlantic's balance sheet.
