100% of Alcidion on the 18th of August 2015.

Alcidion has announced a \$1.75 million contract with the Northern Territory Department of Health (NTDH) over

a period of 60 months. The contact relates to the installation and commissioning of the Miya platform within the

Royal Darwin and Alice Springs hospitals' emergency departments (Hospitals) and is an extension of previous

work conducted with the NTDH.

Of the gross revenue, approximately \$1.33m is representative of the initial installation and commissioning of
