CELTIC DELIVERS COMMUNITY TRAINING PROGRAMS IN QUEENSLAND CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

- **Delivery Services Agreement signed and training fully subscribed for initial course at central Queensland correctional facility beginning 18th January**
- **Agreement to deliver Youth Justice Services program beginning late January 2016**
- **Probation and Parole Services training program to begin January/February 2016**

The Celtic Training & Consultancy team (Celtic) are entering into a series of partnerships with Corrective Services under the Department of Attorney General in Queensland, with the view to a strategic state-wide roll-out as demand builds following successful delivery of the initial program. The Queensland team has developed an accredited program in consultation with Corrective Services to meet the needs of the most marginalised and institutionalised members of the community. iCollege (through Celtic) are launching the first program of the year at a correctional centre in central Queensland in January 2016 which is fully subscribed and on target.

Probation and Parole services, as well as some community services organisations are making plans to launch a similar training program with Celtic in the coming weeks. The most exciting program for iCollege is the launch of a tailor made training for clients of Youth Justice Services. This program will launch during late January in the Brisbane metropolitan area. These young people are securing new opportunities to work with some of the best trainers in the industry. Given that there are 11 Correctional facilities in Queensland this program signals the start of a very exciting and ongoing opportunity for iCollege.
