Testing Operations Continue at Warro-5 and 6

Transerv Energy (ASX: TSV) is pleased to announce that testing operations at Warro-5 and Warro-6 continue.

At both wells, planned maintenance work on the jet pumps during the past week interrupted testing operations for two days.


At Warro-5, clean-up flows have recommenced. While the well is still recovering stimulation fluids, gas flow rates are presently in excess of 0.55 mmcfd and continue rising since testing was restarted. Fluid recovery rates have dropped by a factor of 3 over the same period.

Following the maintenance work, Warro-6 has remained shut in to undergo a pressure build up period. Prior to the shut in, the well continued to produce gas at greater than 1 mmcfd with decreasing liquid rates.
