SECONDARY TRADING NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 708A(5) OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT 2001 ("Act")

On 19 February 2016, Blackham Resources Limited ("**the Company**") issued a total of 350,000 fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of the Company. 150,000 of these shares were issued pursuant to an agreement for consulting services and 200,000 of the shares were issued pursuant to the exercise of Company options issued under the Blackham Employee Incentive Plan.

The Act restricts the on-sale of securities issued without disclosure, unless the sale is exempt under section 708 or 708A of the Act. By the giving of this notice, a sale of the shares noted above will fall within the exemption in section 708A(5) of the Act.

The Company hereby notifies ASX under paragraph 708A(5)(e) of the Act that, as at 19 February 2016:

- a) The Company issued the Shares without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Act;
- b) The Company has complied with the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Act as they apply to the Company, and section 674 of the Act; and
- c) There is no information:
 - a. That has been excluded from a continuous disclosure notice in accordance with the ASX Listing Rules; and
 - b. That investors and their professional advisers would reasonably require for the purpose of making an informed assessment of:
 - i. The assets and liabilities, financial position and performance, profits and losses and prospects of the Company; or
 - ii. The rights and liabilities attaching to the Shares.
