2014 Significant Improvement

NB: Etherstack year end is 31 December, all figures quoted in USD\$

Revenue Up ~70%

- Expected revenues for H1 2014 (30 June 2014) increase 70%
- H1 2014 expected to be greater than \$3m vs H1 2013 \$1.78m

Costs Down \$2m+

- \$1.3m (annualised) of costs removed from business in H2 2013
- Further \$0.7m costs (annualised) reduced in H1 2014

Royalty growth

- Royalty revenue for H1 2014 ahead of comparable period in 2013
- Further royalty growth foreseen in H2 2014 from new royalty streams



2013 Comparison

2013 ESK Review

- Reduced US govt spending in 2012/2013 caused industry wide impact and contraction
- Delay in commencement of major contract and unexpected loss of established US defence client project contributed to an unusually poor year for Etherstack
- FY2013 revenue \$5.2m (loss \$4.5m)

2014 to date

- Improvements in long term royalty streams and increased product sales have seen significant improvement (~70%+ revenue increase) over corresponding period (2013 H1)
- Substantial cost reductions undertaken by company will deliver savings in FY2014
- Positive outlook for H2 orders, prospects and increased royalty streams

Networks Division

Existing Clients

- Strong revenue for networks division from upgrades to existing networks in Australia and North America
- Continued support revenue growth
- Further expansion on five digital radio networks in Australia, US & Canada expected in H2 2014 (three utilities, two public safety)

New Products

- Etherstack to undertake first commercial pilots of LTE25 "push to talk over cellular" (PoC) technology for public safety using LTE (4G) networks in Q3 2014
- Etherstack's PoC technology currently being evaluated by public safety agencies in US, Australia & UK

- New wireless technologies under continual development
- Licensed to 3rd parties and used by other Etherstack groups for development of other Etherstack products

New Major Royalty Stream Q3 2014

- Delivered by Etherstack Japan group
- First royalty receipts expected Q3 2014
- Will propel further royalty growth in H2 2014 and expected to provide royalties from this source for ~10 years





New Tactical Network – Go Box

SFFR-6 Transportable Basestation "Go Box"

- Tactical base station allowing ad-hoc networks to be rapidly created for public safety, military, utilities and resource sectors
- Production commenced Q1 2014
- Joint project between Etherstack RF Group (UK) and Networks Division
- Currently in use by Australian & US law enforcement agencies
- New distribution channels being established globally for the product
- New revenue stream for the company will assist growth in H2 2014 & FY 2015

- Delivery of new technologies to this client base
- Working with Etherstack Protocols Division, delivered successfully new technology in H1 2014 to existing client that will see royalty growth in H2 2014 and future years
