TERMS OF JUDGMENT/ORDER

1 Pursuant to the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) subsection 411(4)(b) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Act), the scheme of arrangement between the plaintiff, Murchison Metals Ltd ACN 078 257 799 (MMX), and the holders of ordinary shares in MMX, other than Excluded Shareholders, in the form contained in Annexure C of the Explanatory Memorandum, which is Exhibit P1 in this proceeding, be approved.

2 Pursuant to subsection 411(12) of the Act, MMX be exempted from compliance with subsection 411(11) of the Act in relation to Order 1.

3 A reference to an Excluded Shareholder in these orders means: (a) Mercantile Investment Company Limited (MVT); (b) Associates (within the meaning given in the Corporations Act 2001) of MVT; (c) any nominees or custodians of an Associate of MVT; and (d) any nominees or custodians of MVT.
