

Glasgow Commonwealth Games

Over the past 12 months, Phoslock Water Solutions Limited (ASX: PHK) has participated in a major project to improve water quality in Glasgow's Strathclyde Loch, the venue for the two triathlon events at next week's Commonwealth Games.

The project has been a joint initiative of a number of organizations, including the Glasgow 2014 Organizing Committee, the Scottish Government, the North Lanarkshire Council and environmental consultants, APEM. *Phoslock* has been applied to reduce phosphate levels and mitigate against the risk of blue green algal blooms which have been a problem in the loch for many years.
