
- Titan is an energy and infrastructure services group focused on the growing Qld CSG industry




Map – CSG Qld Overview



- Three Major QLD CSG-LNG Plants draw gas largely from Bowen and Surat basin's which feed through hub's to the processing plants on Curtis Island (Gladstone)
- Large areas of both basins are yet to be explored
- \$1.5bn of sustainable upstream capex expected post-construction

- Organic and acquisition growth → Opportunities which are complimentary to our core business












Qld CSG Well Profile

- Low likelihood of Arrow LNG proceeding indicates peak will be shallower but over a longer duration



- Increasing tendering activity in NT, WA and SA




Outlook


FY14
