Anticipated Impairment of Paralana Project Asset

The Company wishes to advise, that as a direct consequence of the lapsing of government grants announced on 21 July 2014, the carrying value of the Paralana Project asset has been reviewed (in accordance with AASB 6 – Exploration for and Evaluation of Mineral Resources) and a material non-cash impairment is anticipated to be recorded in the Company's financial statements as at 30 June 2014.

AASB 6 - Exploration for and Evaluation of Mineral Resources, requires that exploration assets be assessed for impairment when facts and circumstances suggest that the carrying amount of the exploration asset may exceed its recoverable amount.

In considering the requirements under AASB 6, and subject to a final audit opinion being provided on the financial statements as at 30 June 2014. The Company has recognised, that without the government grant funding, it will be unable to fund the project in the foreseeable future. The Company therefore anticipates a non-cash impairment to the Paralana Project asset of approximately \$17 million.
