Ecosave signs 5 new contracts for EPCs, GESPs and Automation

Revenue financial year to date plus backlog from contracts secured by Ecosave now totals A\$18.7M globally. The increase in backlog is due to a number of new contract wins across Australia, New Zealand and the US.

Since August 31st, Ecosave's Australian operations have secured a further 2 Victorian Government Energy Performance Contracts (EPCs) with a combined value of A\$2.84M. This is in addition to the A\$2.9M in Victorian Government EPCs secured in August.

Ecosave has also secured a Guaranteed Energy Savings Project (GESP) for a New Zealand based University with a value of NZ\$0.45M. This is our second significant New Zealand based contract win in recent weeks and is representative of Ecosave's increased activity in the New Zealand market.

Ecosave Automation, based in Philadelphia, has secured a further 2 projects with a combined value of US\$1.2M.

The aggregate of revenue financial year to date and the backlog incorporating these additional contract wins totals A\$18.7M.
