GrainCorp Limited (ASX: GNC)

Ports Mandatory Code of Conduct & ACCC exemption of GrainCorp's Carrington terminal in Newcastle

The Port Terminal Access (Bulk Wheat) Code of Conduct (the "Code") came into effect on 30 September 2014.

GrainCorp has been notified by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission ("ACCC") of its decision to exempt GrainCorp's Carrington terminal in Newcastle. The exemption means that GrainCorp will be subject to a lower level of regulation (Parts 1 and 2 of the Code only) at this terminal.

GrainCorp welcomes the decision as it highlights the flexibility of the Code and the ability of the ACCC to allow exemptions where port service providers are operating in a competitive environment.

GrainCorp will seek the exemption of its other terminals where possible and according to the ACCC exemption process.
