Re: Wotif.com Holdings Limited: Request for Trading Halt

Wotif.com Holdings Limited (**WTF**) requests a trading halt from quotation of its listed securities commencing prior to 10.00 am (Brisbane time) on 9 October 2014.

1. Reason for trading halt

The trading halt is requested pending the outcome of the meeting of WTF's shareholders to consider whether or not to approve the acquisition by Expedia Investments Australia Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Expedia, Inc. (**Expedia**) of WTF by way of a scheme of arrangement (**Scheme Meeting**). The Scheme Meeting is scheduled to commence at 10.00 am on 9 October 2014.

WTF requests a trading halt to prevent people who attend the Scheme Meeting from being more informed than the market generally as a result of disclosures made at the Scheme Meeting.

WTF is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.

2. Length of trading halt

WTF will release the results of the Scheme Meeting to the market following conclusion of the Scheme Meeting, at which time the trading halt can be lifted. WTF anticipates that this will be no later than the close of business on 9 October 2014.
