MIRVAC INDUSTRIAL TRUST RESULTS OF MIX UNITHOLDER MEETING

Mirvac Funds Management Limited ("MFML"), the responsible entity of Mirvac Industrial Trust [ASX: MIX] ("MIX"), advises that the proposal by AustFunding Pty Limited¹ to acquire all of the units in MIX (the "Proposal"), has been approved by MIX Unitholders at a Meeting which was held in Sydney today.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 3.13.2, a report showing the total number of votes cast on each poll is attached.

Implementation of the Proposal remains subject to the satisfaction of the conditions precedent including receipt of judicial advice from the Supreme Court of New South Wales at the second court hearing which is scheduled to take place at 9:30am on Friday, 21 November 2014.
