Results of Annual General Meeting

Results of the Annual General Meeting of Shareholders held today are summarised as follows:

Resolution 1: The resolution to adopt the Remuneration Report was passed on a vote by poll.

Poll details in respect of this resolution were as follows:

- (i) there were a total of 7,802,702 votes cast in favour of the resolution including 7,300,086 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote for the resolution;
- (ii) there were a total of 1,831,147 votes cast against the resolution all of which were proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote against the resolution;
- (iii) there were a total of 37,798 votes abstained including 33,798 in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy abstain on the resolution;
- (iv) there were 7,000 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy may vote at the proxy's discretion.

Resolution 2: The resolution to **re-elect Mr. Glenn Molloy as a Director** was <u>passed</u> by a show of hands.

Proxy details in respect of this resolution were as follows:

- (i) there were 25,344,852 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote for the resolution;
- (ii) there were 29,927 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote against the resolution;
- (iii) there were 3,000 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy abstain on the resolution;
- (iv) there were 60,919 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy may vote at the proxy's discretion.

Resolution 3: The resolution to re-elect Mr. Graeme Webb as a Director was passed by a show of hands.

- (i) there were 25,344,852 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote for the resolution;
- (ii) there were 29,927 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy vote against the resolution;

- (iv) there were 60,919 proxy votes in respect of which the appointments specified that the proxy may vote at the proxy's discretion.
