Callabonna meet with Mali Government to discuss Ansongo scoping study

On a recent visit to South Africa for the Mining Indaba Conference and investor meetings, Jeff Williams, Director of Callabonna Resources, met with members of the Mali government to discuss the next phase of the Manganese scoping study for Ansongo, Eastern Mali.
