1) On 2 October 2014 an agreement was entered into with the Bergen Global Opportunity Fund, LP ('Bergen') providing an equity drawdown facility of up to US\$34.9M and a US\$2.5M convertible note. As at 31 March 2015, the total funds received from Bergen was US\$3.676m. During the

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term of the agreement, subject to meeting equity conditions, Bergen will invest up to \$US700k per month in Prima's equity over a 24 month period, with the option to increase each of the monthly tranches to an amount not exceeding US\$1.5 million by mutual consent of Bergen and the Company.
