

## **ASX Statement**

## **Distribution Agreement**

Following the previous announcements of 25 March 2015 and 01 April 2015. Lindsay Australia Limited (Lindsay) advises that in relation to its termination of the distribution agreement with Orora Limited (Orora), and following the hearing held Monday 18 May 2015, the Supreme Court of Victoria has discharged the interim injunction granted on 01 April 2015 that restrained Lindsay from acting on the termination. As a consequence of the injunction being discharged, Lindsay is permitted to obtain supply of packaging products from Visy Board Pty Ltd.

The matter has now been placed on the Commercial List of the Supreme Court of Victoria to be heard at a date to be determined. At this hearing the Court will assess the parties' respective claims against one another arising out of the termination of the distribution agreement with Orora.

Although the outcome of the future hearing is unknown, the discharge of the injunction enables Lindsay to strengthen the company's end-to-end logistics, packaging and rural products solution for the horticulture sector through the strategic partnership with Visy.
