<u>Aeris Environmental SmartENERGY System Receives Accreditation as a Registered Energy</u> Saving Activity from NSW HVAC & Refrigeration Efficiency Program

Aeris Environmental Ltd (ASX:AEI) is pleased to announce that it has achieved accreditation for its integrated SmartENERGY system under IPART, New South Wales (NSW) Government's Economic Advisor and Policy Think Tank and Administrator for the NSW Energy Savings Scheme (ESS).

The Energy Savings Scheme is governed by NSW legislation and reduces electricity consumption in NSW by creating financial incentives for organisations to invest in Energy Savings Projects and covers energy savings achieved by installing, improving or replacing energy savings equipment.

Applicable Energy Saving Certificates (ESC) will be subject to this Registered Energy Saving Activity (RESA) and have resulted from the initial validation of SmartENERGY in a high profile site in NSW, included installation, commissioning, monitoring, measurement, verification and reporting. This was undertaken in conjunction with Ecovantage, an industry leader in the energy efficiency market and accredited in the New South Wales, Victorian and South Australian Energy Savings Schemes.

Aeris CEO, Mr Peter Bush said, "This is a significant milestone for Aeris and its customers and now builds on the outstanding ROI and ongoing, validated benefits of SmartENERGY by delivering a further and potentially meaningful rebate over the first 5 years of the installation."
