
Broken Hill Prospecting 'BPL' - Business Model

- > Low CAPEX, short time frame, early returns








- Undertaken by Geos Mining (July 2015)

- ➤ Using 2.5% THM cut




- Twice the grade of nearby HMS mines

- Maiden Resource estimate for Magic expected August


Copi North HMS Deposit






Copi North HMS Deposit – INSET 5







Magic HMS Deposit








Drilling April 2015 Magic HMS Deposit
