Superloop Network Rollout Update

Superloop Limited (**ASX:SLC**) is pleased to provide an update on its network rollout in Singapore and Australia.

During the quarter, the Company completed the construction of the initial 110km fibre optic network in Singapore, with 624 core fibre optic cable hauled through the company's duct network. As at 30 September, the Company has installed a total of 117km. The network is live, offering customers access to diverse paths between Global Switch, Equinix SG1, Equinix SG2 and Digital Realty (Jurong). The Company is also in the final stages of connecting the Tuas and Katong Cable Landing Stations and Equinix SG3 to the network.

Following the Company's 8 July 2015 announcement confirming the completion of the Brisbane and Melbourne networks, we are now also pleased to confirm that the Sydney network is operational, with all key sites connected and services handed over to cornerstone customers.

The Company notes that there is a small blockage affecting the hauling of the final 1km of fibre optic cable required to complete the diverse path to two sites on the Sydney network. The Company is working with the network operator to remediate the blockage and expects to have the diverse path completed and operational during October.

Mr Abrahams, CEO of Superloop commented, "I am excited with the progress that Superloop has made on its Singapore and Australian Network rollout. I am proud of the team, as well as our partners, who have worked well together to build Superloop's core networks."

The Company owns and operates a strategic underground duct network spanning approximately 120 kilometres in the Asian telecommunications hub of Singapore. The Singapore fibre optic network interconnects major data centre and submarine cable landing station locations including Equinix SG1, SG2, Global Switch and Digital Realty (Jurong), and will soon connect to the Katong and Tuas Cable Landing Stations and Equinix SG3.
