6	Purpose of the issue (If issued as consideration for the acquisition of assets, clearly identify those assets)	As announced to the ASX on 1 October 2015, the Company, through its wholly owned subsidiary Stargroup Investments Limited, has entered into an Asset Sale Agreement with Cash Plus Australia Pty Limited to acquire an automatic teller machine network comprising 109 machines together with some supporting ATM site agreements and modems (the Acquisition). The consideration for the Acquisition is \$6.5 million, which is to be paid 50% in cash and 50% in shares issued at \$0.04 per share. Funds raised under the intended new issues the subject of this announcement will be used in part to fund the Acquisition should the Acquisition be approved at the Company's 2015 Annual General Meeting to be convened to be held on 30 November 2015. The balance of the funds raised, including if shareholder approval is not given, will be used by the Company for general working capital purposes and other potential acquisitions.
