Brambles Limited is pleased to announce the appointment of George Zoghbi as a Non-Executive Director, effective 1 January 2016. Mr Zoghbi has extensive international consumer packaged goods and supply-chain experience. He is currently Chief Operating Officer of US commercial businesses for Kraft Heinz Company, based in Chicago, USA.

In his current role, Mr Zoghbi leads Kraft Heinz's US business, with annual sales revenue of US\$19 billion. Prior to the merger of Kraft Foods Group and Heinz in July 2015, Mr Zoghbi was Chief Operating Officer of Kraft, having held several other senior executive positions with Kraft in the USA and Australia from 2007 onwards.

Before joining Kraft, he held a number of executive roles with Fonterra Cooperative and various managerial and sales roles with Associated British Foods.
