

ePAT SELECTED FOR PRESTIGIOUS NATIONAL iAWARDS

MinQuest Limited (ASX:MNQ) (“MinQuest” or “the Company”) is pleased to advise Australian-based medical research company ePAT Pty Ltd (“ePAT”) has been selected as a finalist for the AIIA National iAwards for its revolutionary mobile medical applications.

At the 25th WAITTA Incite Awards held in Perth on Friday 24 June, ePAT, represented by ePAT developer Mustafa Atee from the School of Pharmacy at Curtin University, was chosen to represent Western Australia as a finalist at the AIIA National iAwards under the Best Student Project of the Year (Peter Fillery) Award category.

The key goal of the iAwards is to discover, recognise and reward ICT innovations that have the potential to, or are already having a positive impact on the community – at home, in the office and on a global scale.

ePAT is developing mobile medical applications that use facial recognition software to facilitate and improve pain assessment in patients that are unable to communicate.

The App is being developed and rolled out in two phases; one for patients with dementia who have lost the ability to communicate with their carers and the second for infants who have not yet learnt to speak.

The ePAT Apps are being developed for the global market, initially for health care professionals and professional carers of patients with dementia and subsequently for parents and carers of infants.

ePAT chief executive officer Professor Jeff Hughes said it was an honour to be selected as a finalist for the National iAwards.

“The selection of ePAT as a National iAwards finalist once again highlights the significance of these applications in identifying the presence and intensity of pain in non-communicative adults and pre-verbal children,” Professor Hughes said.

The AIIA National iAwards will be held in Melbourne in September this year.

In April, ePAT was selected to take part CSIRO’s ON Accelerator program to fast-track science and technology ideas into commercially viable innovation opportunities (refer to announcement dated 26 April 2016).

MinQuest has signed a binding Heads of Agreement with ePAT to acquire 100% of the Company (refer to announcement dated 14 April 2016).
